EVENT DAY DETAILS – ELITE CLIMB

- Location: Metro Toronto Convention Centre (MTCC), North Building. Please arrive at the MTCC and head to climber check-in in the main lobby on the ground level. If you have already attended advance check-in, you can go directly to coat check in Hall A and then proceed to the queue to climb. You will then be directed outside to walk to the base of the CN Tower to start your climb.
- *Date & Time:* Sunday, May 3. **Please check-in at 6:00 a.m.**
- Adult climbers must raise a minimum of \$125 to be eligible to climb and youth (13-18) must raise a minimum of \$75 to be eligible to climb.
- **This is a HANDS & POCKETS FREE climb.** For safety reasons, climbers must be hands-free and cannot carry anything during the climb, including water.

NOT permitted: cell phones, water bottles, hats, headphones (incl. ear buds), buffs, smart glasses, weighted vests, wrist weights and other rec. equipment, food/candy/gum, coins, costumes, body mounted cameras, smart watches with cameras, backpacks, camel packs, infants/toddlers, etc. may not be carried or worn during the climb.

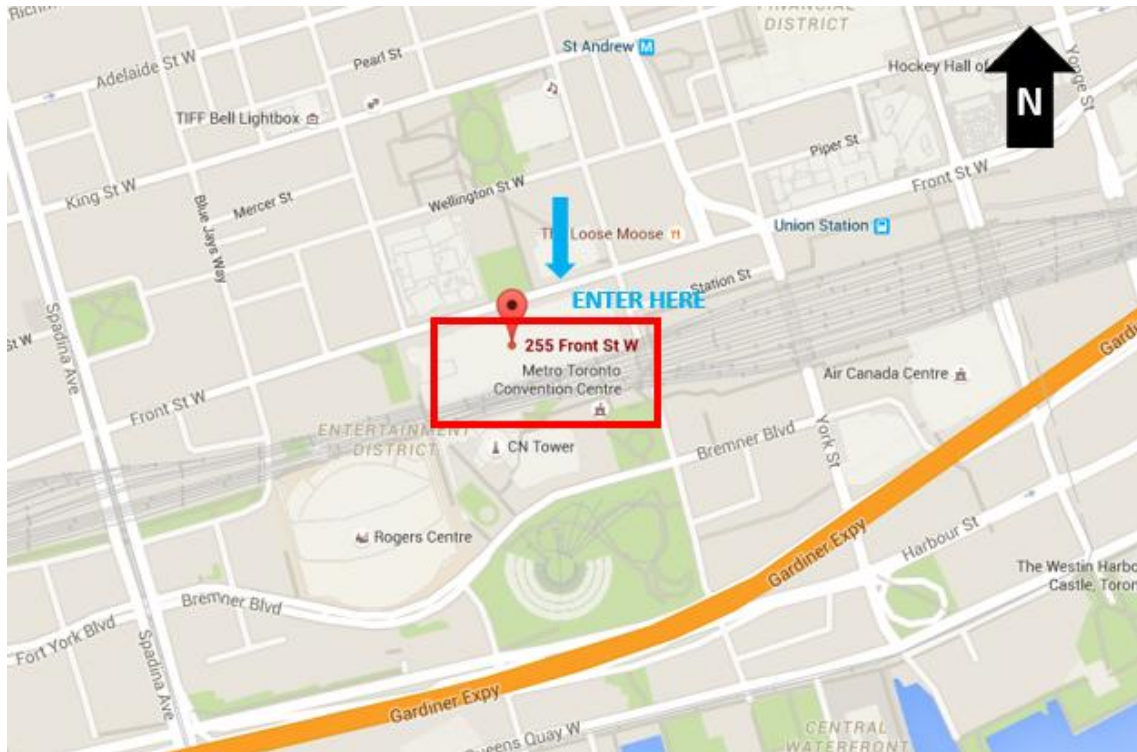
The only items permitted are one piece of ID, one key and/or medication in a zippered pocket. Fitbits/pedometers may be worn (if there's no camera).

- Water will be provided onsite, pre climb at the MTCC and post climb at the top of the CN Tower. No water is permitted during the climb.
- Our complimentary coat check is led by WWF staff and volunteers, and we do our best to keep all items safe and secure. WWF-Canada and the MTCC will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- All climbers must wear proper closed-toe athletic shoes; climbers will not be allowed to climb in sandals, flip-flops, crocs, boots or other inappropriate footwear.
- Get your official Climb time and pick up your free Climb t-shirt and fundraising rewards in the MTCC after your climb.
- The 2026 WWF CN Tower Climb for Nature is restricted to climbers aged 13 and over on the day of the event (May 3, 2026). Climbers between the age of 13 and 18 registering on event day must have a waiver signed by a parent or guardian and may be asked to show ID.
